Technical Theatre Classroom Regulations

Technical Theatre is a hands-on career that involves designing and crafting of theatrical productions. It is extremely important for your safety and the safety of others that you heed all theatre rules. Unsafe behavior in the classroom or the Theatre areas will not be tolerated.

Rules

- 1. You must **always** wear closed-toed flat shoes that cover the top of the foot and toes to class and in the theatre EVERYDAY OF CLASS.
- 2. Always come to class prepared with your Theatre Binder and two #2 pencils.
- 3. Write down the daily objective and the Q.O.T.D. in chronological order **every day** in your binder!
- 4. Respect yourself and respect those around you at all times.
- 5. Follow the 4 P's: Prompt, Prepared, Polite & Productive.
- 6. Always follow all safety rules.

Rewards

- 4. You will achieve a good grade in my class.
- 5. Verbal praise to you and your parents.

Consequences
